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THE JORDAN RIVER HAS DEEP HISTORICAL ROOTS WITHIN JEWISH TRADITION. IT IS THE RIVER THAT THE ISRAELITES CROSSED TO ENTER THE PROMISED LAND, REPRESENTING A TRANSITION FROM THE WILDERNESS TO A NEW BEGINNING. BY CHOOSING THIS SPECIFIC LOCATION FOR HIS BAPTISM, JESUS CONNECTS HIS MISSION TO THE HISTORY OF HIS PEOPLE, REINFORCING THE IDEA OF A NEW COVENANT. THE RIVER SERVES AS A POWERFUL BACKDROP FOR THIS TRANSFORMATIVE EVENT, SYMBOLIZING PURIFICATION AND THE WASHING AWAY OF SINS.
